In the U.S., he has held professorial or Director of Music positions at Trinity Church in Boston, Westminster Choir College in Princeton, American University, Christ Church Cathedral in St. Louis, the University of Missouri, and with the St. Louis Chamber Orchestra and Chorus. Dr. Arnatt is currently Director of Music and Organist at St. John's Church in Beverly Farms, Massachusetts. He is known internationally for his choral, organ, and brass compositions. Dr. Arnatt is past President of the American Guild of Organists.
