


Familiar Songs In Second And Third Positions

As an introduction to playing in positions we simply play some familiar songs from volumes 1 and 2 in new position to learn the new distances between our fingers. These distances become smaller the higher we move up the finger board. Before starting each song we first look for a note we can compare to an open string. It is very important to move our thumb to the new position. For now it should always be opposite the second finger, it should not stay in first position when the other fingers play in second or third position.
