To The Director:

"Narnian Dance" was inspired by a scene from the book Prince Caspian, the second of the seven Chronicles of Narnia by C.S. Lewis. Written in a flowing latin-rock style (ala Pat Metheny) this chart is sure to challenge and reward.

The opening theme at measure 16 should be played very legato except where noted. Strive for an even balance between all three melody instruments. The soli for the rhythm section in section 64 has optional tenor saxophone parts, but these should not be used once your rhythm section has the lines up to performance level.

At measure 145 the volume level of the chart should drop way down and slowly build to a very exciting ending. Watch the quick key changes here. Be sure everyone brings out the eighth note ascending line in the last three measures, especially guitar and piano.

Good Luck! I really hope you enjoy this piece.
