## Performance Note

Instruments: 2 flutes are preferred, but the 2 nd flute part may be played by an oboe if the order is changed for stanza 2. Here the flute plays the solo melody, and the oboe enters at measure 31. For the remaining two stanzas the beginning order is restored. Violins may be substituted for both flutes, or a violin may substitute for the second flute. If none of these instruments are available, a keyboard instrument may be used (organ is preferred since it has more capability to sustain sounds).
