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## **PROGRAM NOTES**

A lyrical statement in melody, Luke Mayernik's *Amendment* (2013) is a beautiful addition to the saxophone repertoire. Written as a melodic vehicle for the alto member of the instrument's family, *Amendment* offers flowing lines ornamented with grace notes reminiscent of Impressionist days gone by.

Cast in a ternary form, the piece begins with a songlike adagio theme that mixes both B major and B minor modalities. The center section of the work begins rhythmically with rapid triplets in the piano before the saxophone enters with a rhythmically charged variation upon the initial theme that propels the listener on a harmonic journey. Following a climax on F-sharp major, the motion settles into a restatement of the lovely B major/minor theme before ending on a sweet-sounding B major triad.

Mayernik's work is brief but moving, and offers the soloist a wonderful opportunity for melodic exploration. Both appealing to the audience and enjoyable for the saxophonist, *Amendment* is a picturesque new piece in the repertoire.
